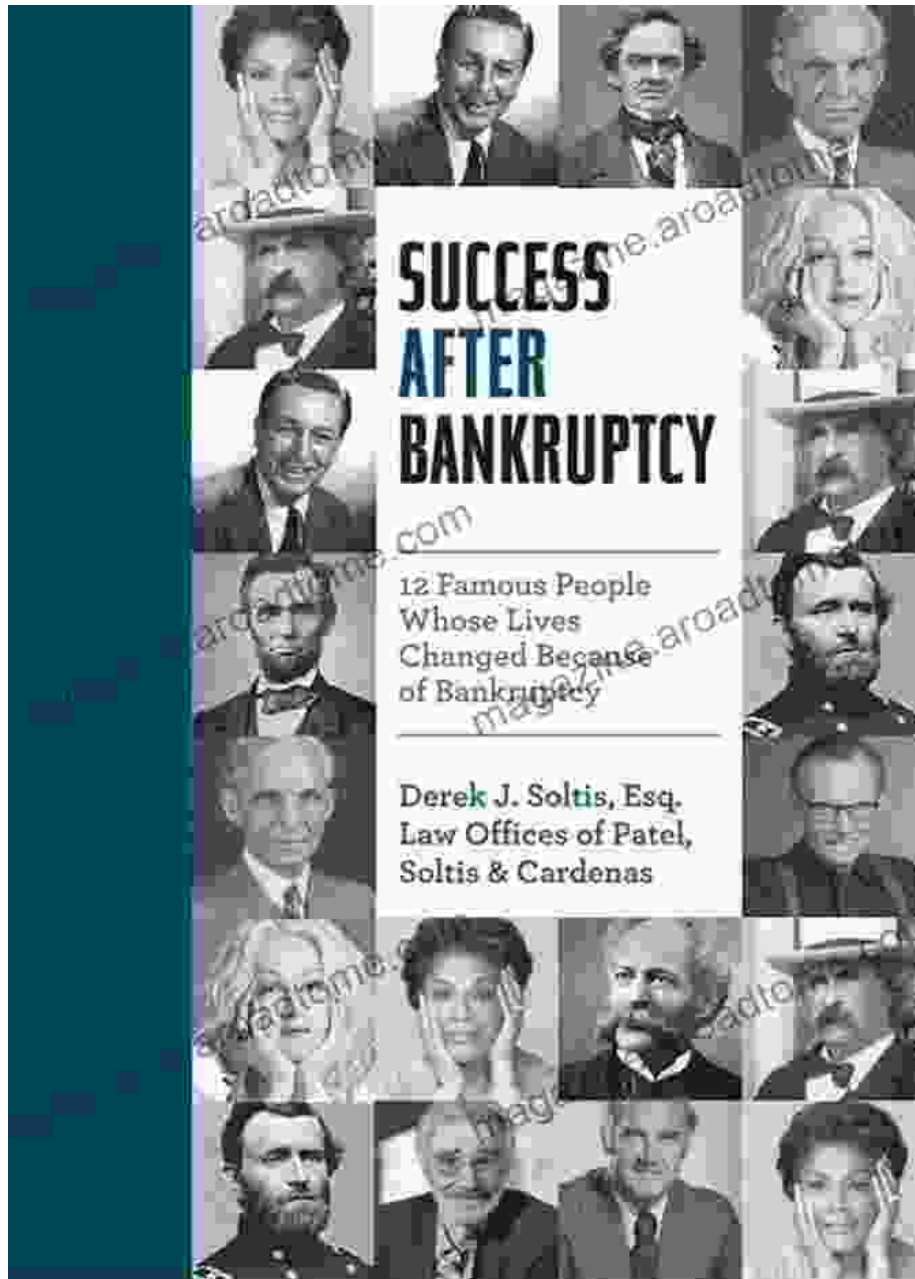

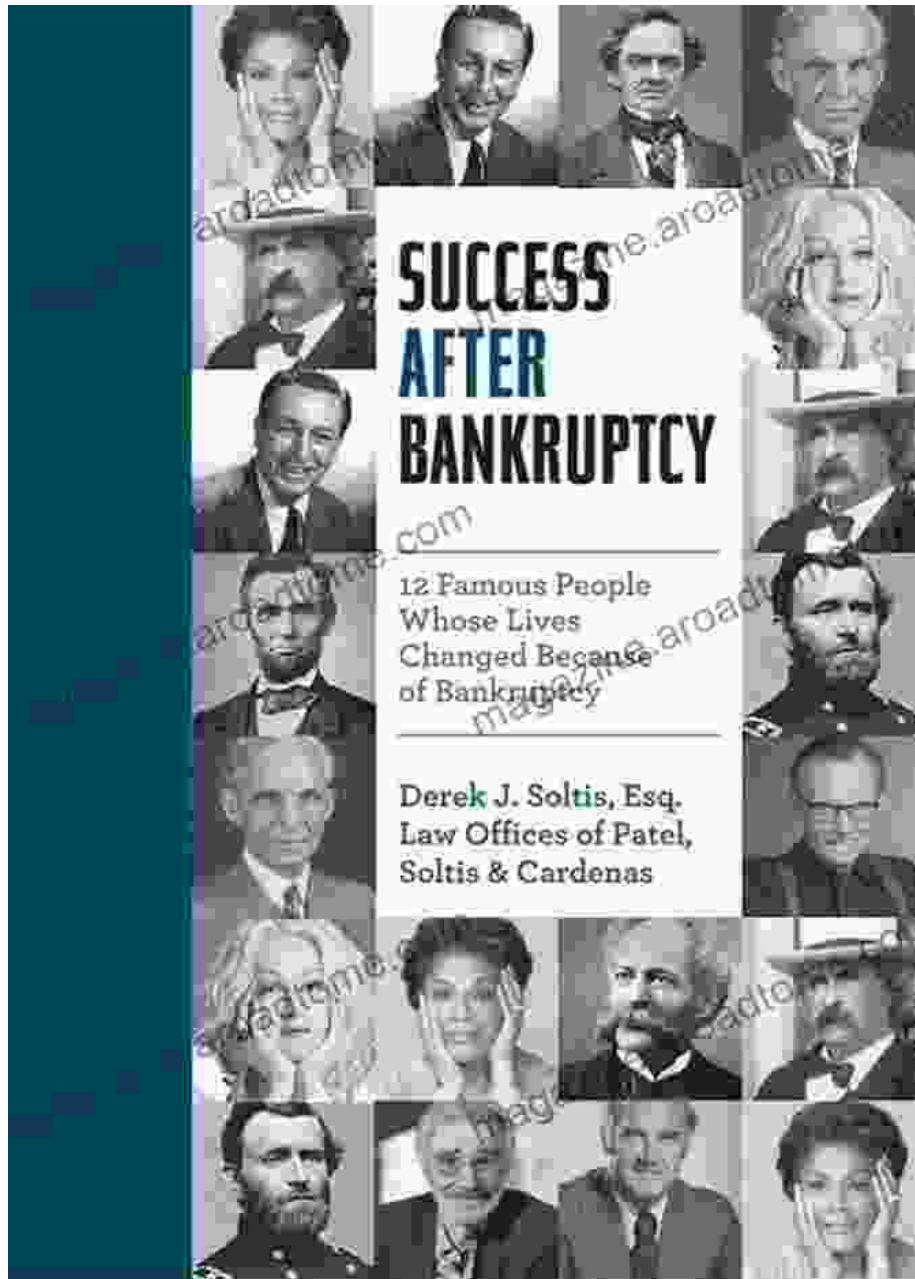

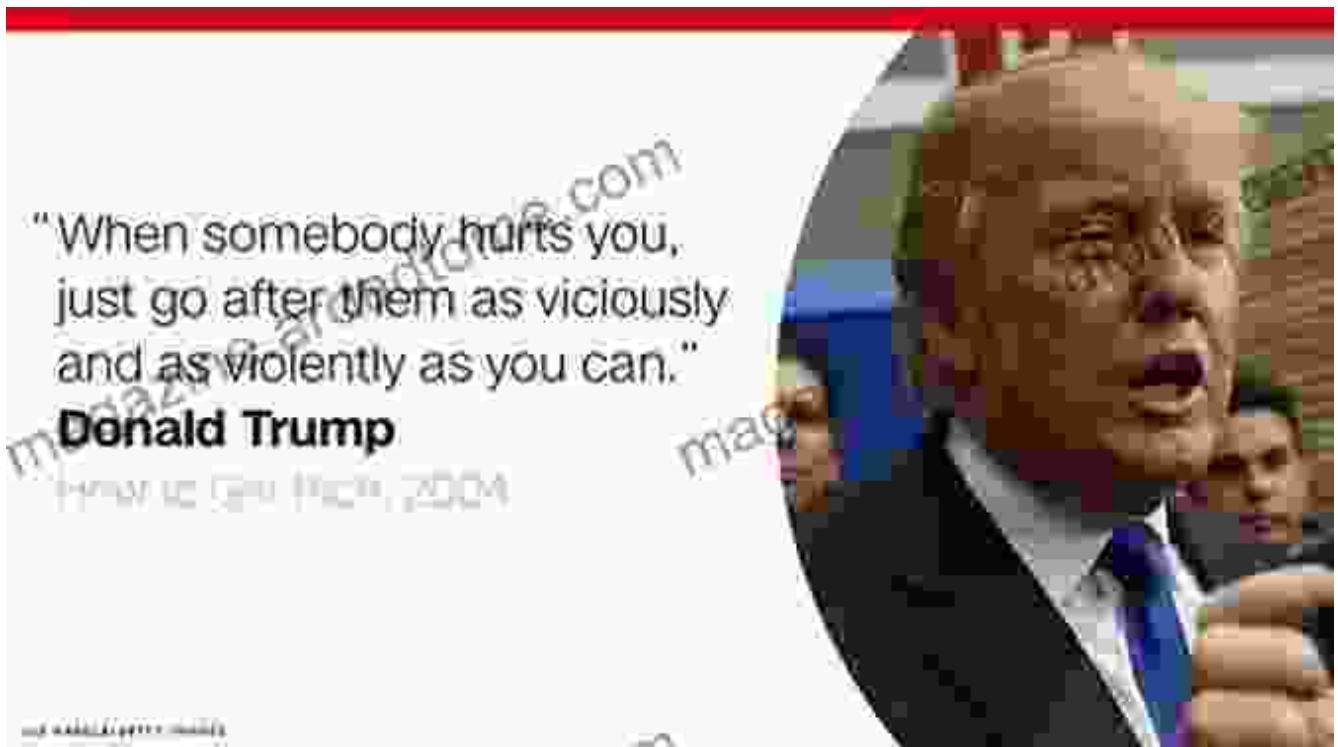

4. Dave Thomas



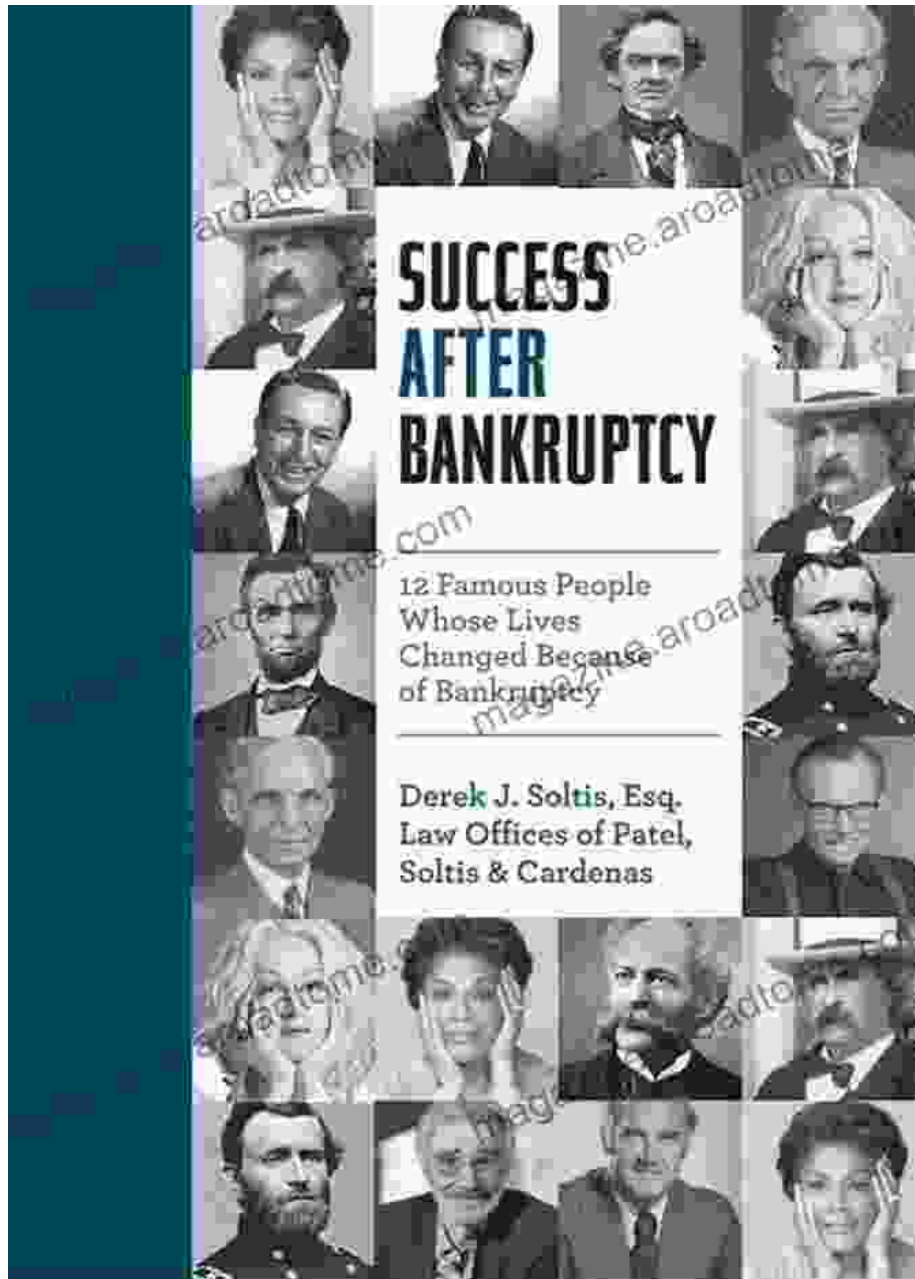

6. Michael Jordan



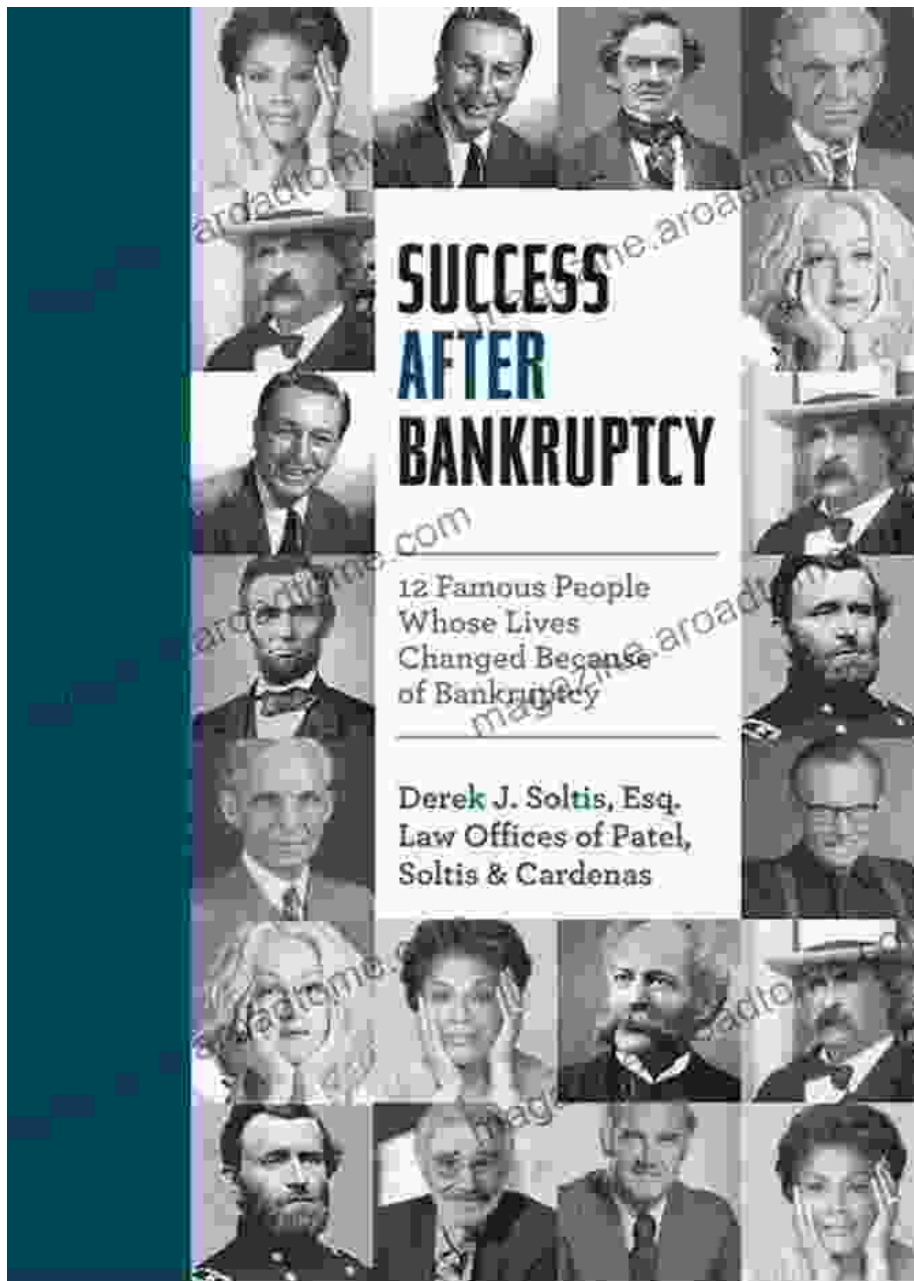

7. Larry King



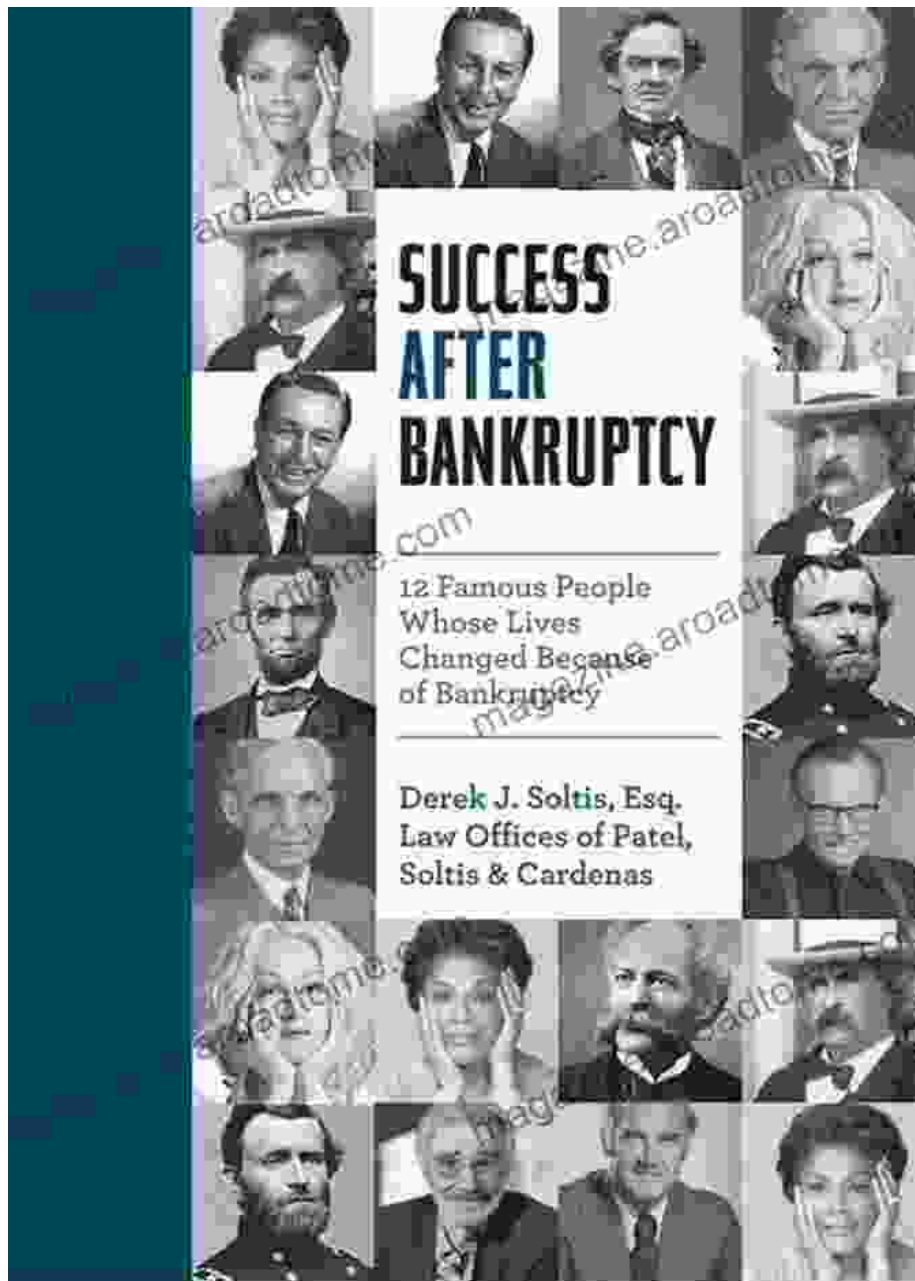

8. Wayne Newton



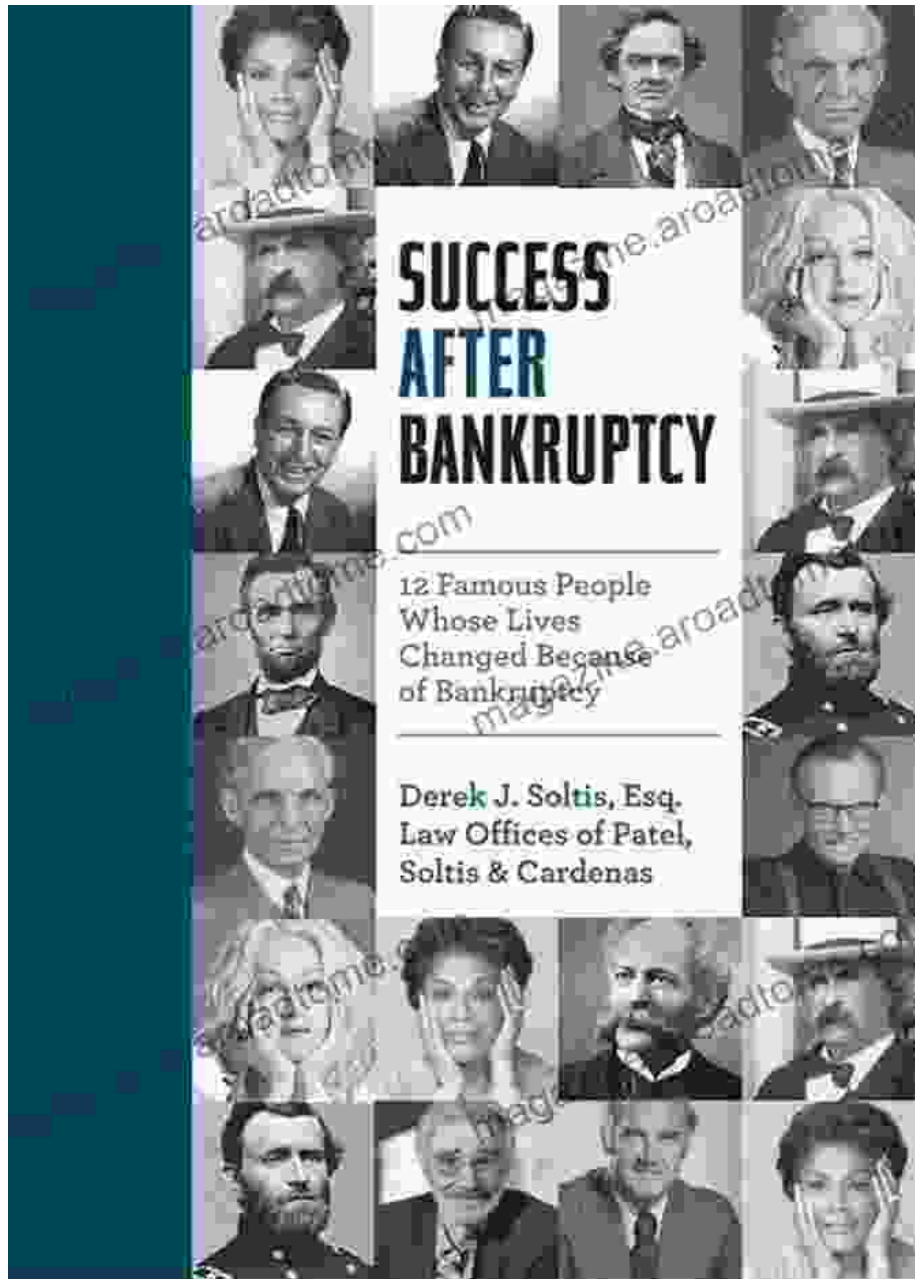

10. MC Hammer



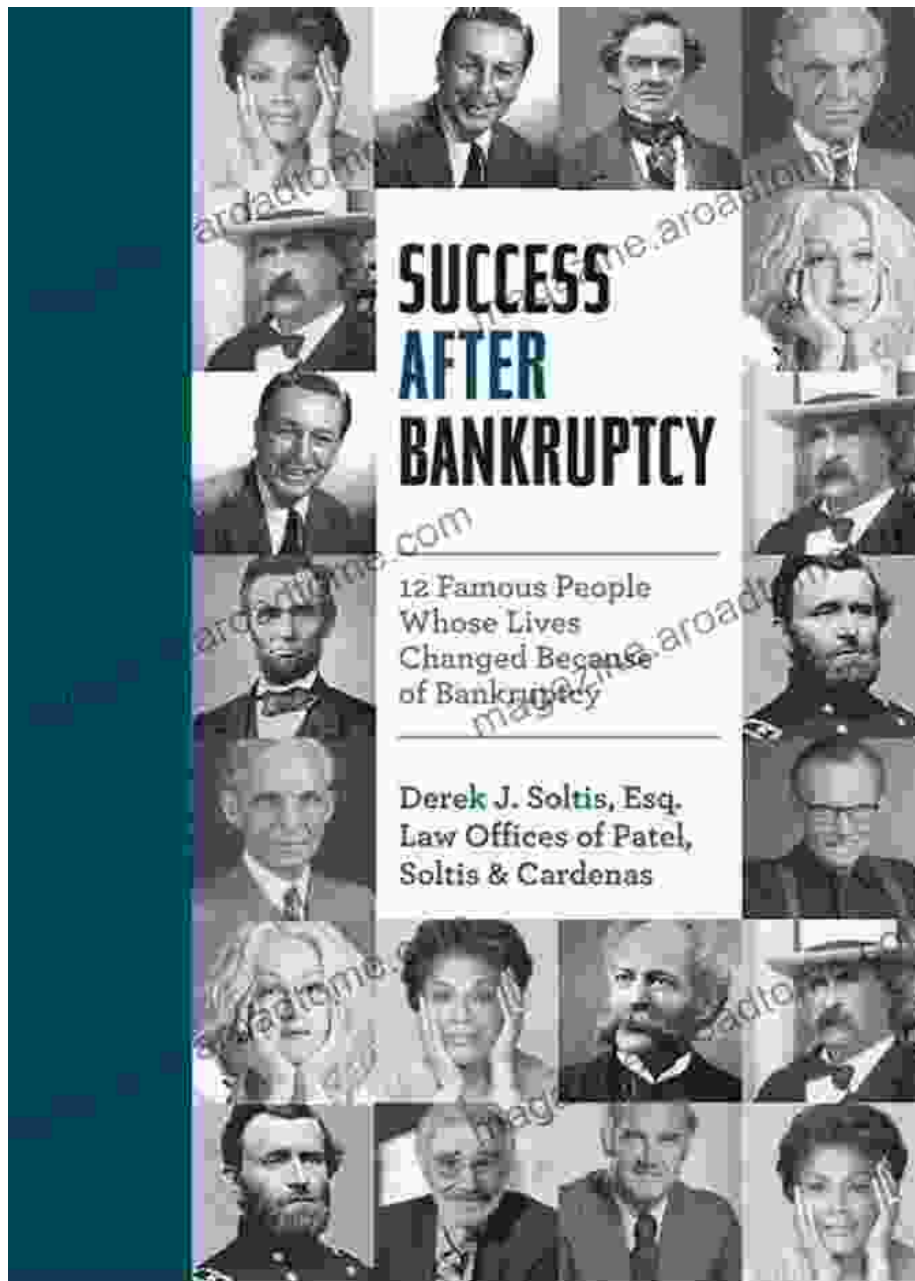

11. Toni Braxton



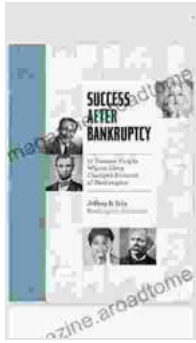

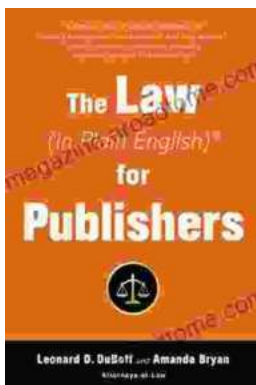
