

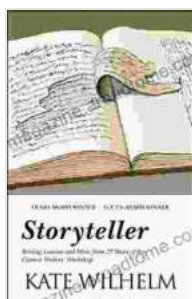

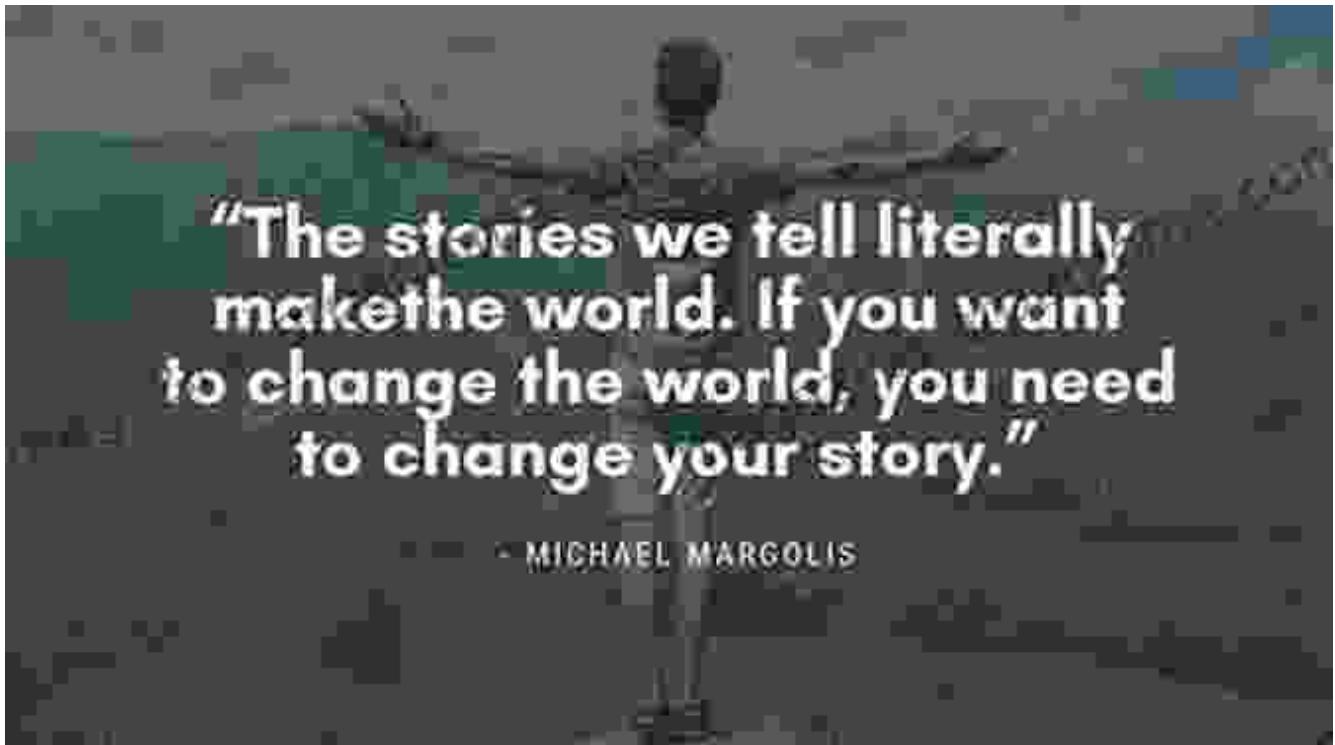

You may include the following suggested ideas:

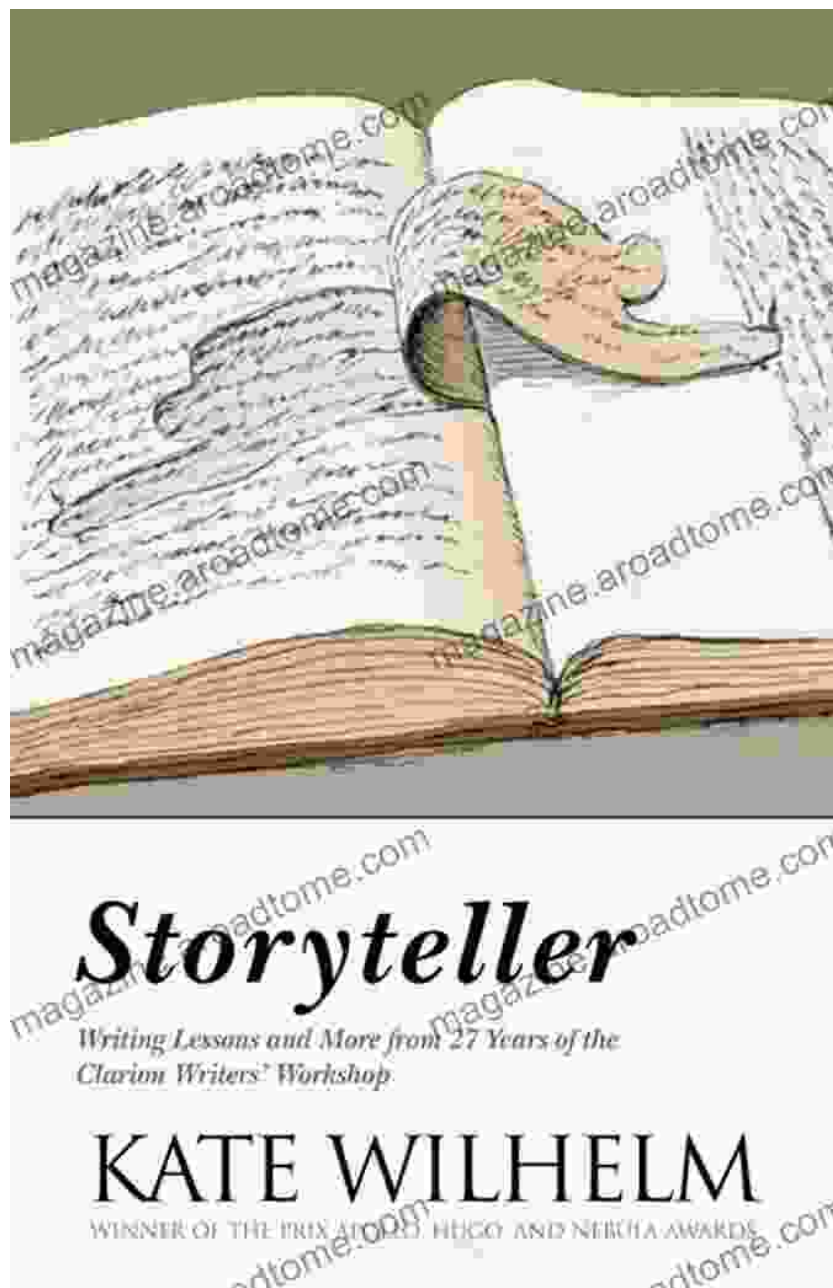
- Introduce the main character or other characters

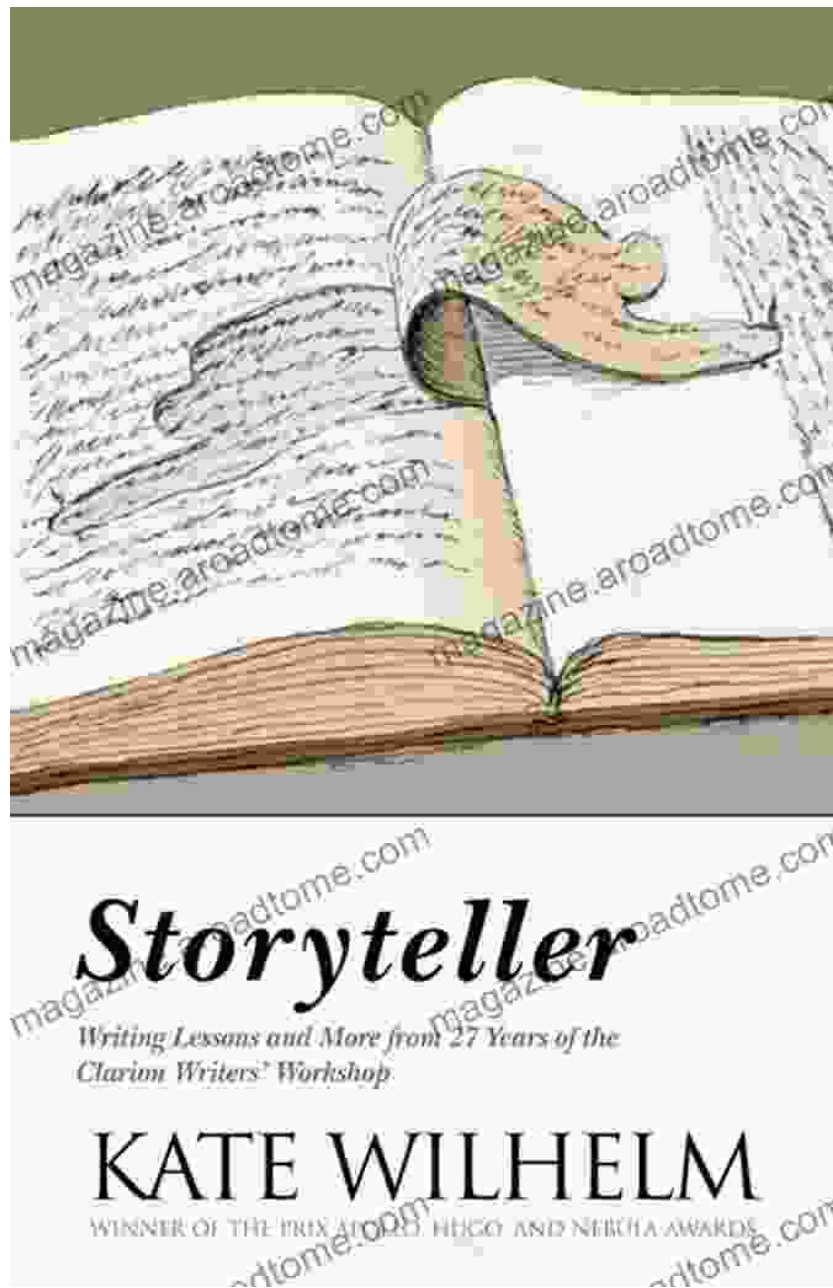

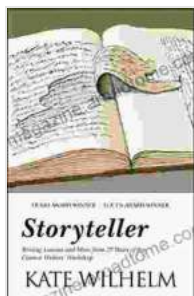

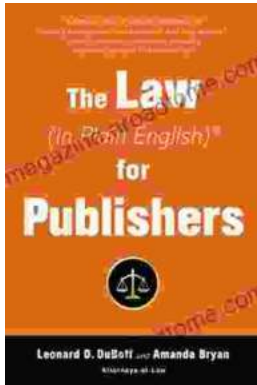
